## CHW Legal Scholarship

The CHW Legal Scholarships and Bursaries are awarded annually. The principal award provides financial support of \$25,000 to a Bermudian student, with outstanding scholastic achievement, who is pursuing a course of study for a law degree, the bar or solicitor's examinations at a recognized institution of higher education, that will qualify the applicant for call to the Bermuda Bar. Bursaries are at the discretion of the Committee.

The scholarship funds are to be used to contribute to the costs of tuition, room and board at the place of study and to the cost of travel to and from the place of study.

A Scholarship selection committee will make the Scholarship award.

The Scholarship Committee will focus on the applicant's evidence of:

- Interest in pursuing a legal career in Bermuda;
- Outstanding scholastic ability;
- Qualities of character and leadership.

Winners of the Scholarship will be chosen on the basis of merit regardless of financial need.

To be eligible for the CHW Legal Scholarship, the candidate must:

- Hold Bermuda status or a Permanent Resident's Certificate;
- Be a student of an approved university or college or otherwise be pursuing a legal qualification;
- Be accepted in an approved legal studies curriculum.

The application form must be completed in full and accompanied by:

- Current Curriculum Vitae
- A typed or handwritten autobiographical essay indicating your academic and/or occupational background, plans for future studies, career objective, civil and extra-curricular activities and achievements;
- Proof of acceptance into a course of legal study;
- Official copies of all educational transcripts which must carry the certification of grades;
- Two character references, provided under confidential cover;
- Two academic references, provided under confidential cover;
- Copy of your birth certificate;
- Letter from the Ministry of Home Affairs attesting to the fact that the applicant has Bermudian status or a copy of your Permanent Resident's Certificate;
- Current medical certificate of good health;

The Scholarship Committee may decline to award the Scholarship should it decide, in its discretion, that there is no suitable candidate.

The Scholarship winner(s) shall keep the Scholarship Committee informed of his /her progress by timely submission of grades or transcripts as issued and such other written reports as may be requested from time to time. Failure to comply may lead to suspension or forfeiture of the Scholarship.

The Scholarship Committee reserves the right to withdraw an award should the winner(s) become involved in any activity that, in it's opinion, places the prestige of the Scholarship in jeopardy.

The applicant accepting the primary CHW Legal Scholarship may be required to decline or renounce, as the case may be, any other award made locally for the duration of the Scholarship, if in the opinion of the Scholarship Committee such award is inconsistent with the grant of the Scholarship.
